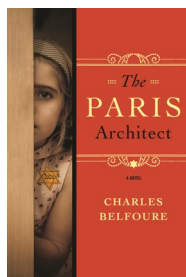


## DENNIS WILSON: "MY LIFE AS A RAIL"

September 7– December 14

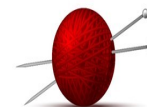
